Pray

- Bind down the spirits of Apathy and Laziness that would keep the people of YHVH from engaging against the evil forces in the world.
- Bind down the spirits of Fear and Intimidation that seek to paralyze believers. Release the Spirits of Courage, Strength, Boldness and Fearlessness. See 1 Peter 5:6-11.
- That we as the Body of Messiah would exude hope, trust, faith, and love to those around us and that we would be ready to give an answer for the reason for our hope. *1 Peter 3:15 "But in your hearts revere Christ as Lord. Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have. But do this with gentleness and respect."*
