Stand, Love, and Possess

“We give thanks to You, O God, we give thanks! For Your wondrous works declare that Your name is near.” Psalm 75:1

“For exaltation comes neither from the east nor from the west nor from the south. But God is the Judge: He puts down one, and exalts another...I will declare forever, I will sing praises to the God of Jacob. ‘All the horns of the wicked I will also cut off, But the horn of the righteous shall be exalted.’” Psalm 75:6-7, 9-10.

We give thanks to You, O LORD, that Your ways are higher than our ways, and Your thoughts are higher than our thoughts. See Isaiah 55:8-9

“Be still, and know that I am God; I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth!” Psalm 46:10

The battle that we are seeing in the physical in our nation is being waged in the heavenlies, and we have the express privilege to intercede in this battle through the Holy Spirit’s leading. God’s Will cannot be thwarted, and His Word shall not return to Him void, *“But it shall accomplish what I please, And it shall prosper in the thing for which I sent it.” Isaiah 55:11*

Ask for the Lord’s wisdom as you pray this week.

“If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all liberally and without reproach, and it will be given to him. But let him ask in faith, with no doubting, for he who doubts is like a wave of the sea driven and tossed by the wind.” James 1:5-6

Pray *“that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him, the eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that you may know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints, and what is the exceeding greatness of His power toward us who believe, according to the working of His mighty power which He worked in Christ when He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly places, far above all principality and power and might and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this age but also in that which is to come.” Ephesians 1:17-21*

In this time, it is important to:

- 1) **Wait on the Lord.** “Wait on the Lord; Be of good courage, and He shall strengthen your heart; Wait, I say, on the Lord!” Psalm 27:14
- 2) **Bridle your tongue; make no agreements with the enemy and choose the words you speak wisely.** “Set a guard, O Lord, over my mouth; keep watch over the door of my lips.” Psalm 141:3
- 3) **Declare and Proclaim the Word of God, remember His promises.** Meditate on Psalm 37, Proverbs 6:16-19, Psalm 9
- 4) **WORSHIP, Express FAITH. Believe God and His prophets.** “Hear me, O Judah and you inhabitants of Jerusalem: Believe in the Lord your God, and you shall be established; believe His prophets, and you shall prosper.” 2 Chronicles 20:20b
- 5) **Love – allow God to work in your heart to make it more like HIS.** “Love suffers long and is kind; love does not envy; love does not parade itself, is not puffed up; does not behave rudely, does not seek its own, is not provoked, thinks no evil; does not rejoice in iniquity, but rejoices in the truth; bears all things, believes all things; hopes all things, endures all things. Love never fails.” 1 Corinthians 13:4-8a

As you pray, apply God’s love – know your position in Christ.

Pray *“that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with might through His Spirit in the inner man, that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith; that you, being rooted and grounded in love, may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the width and length and depth and height—to know the love of Christ which passes knowledge; that you may be filled with all the fullness of God.” Ephesians 3:16-19*

Pray *“that your love may abound still more and more in knowledge and all discernment, that you may approve the things that are excellent, that you may be sincere and without offense till the day of Christ, being filled with the fruits of righteousness which are by Jesus Christ, to the glory and praise of God.” Philipians 1:9-11*

Pray *“that you may be filled with the knowledge of His will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding; that you may walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing Him, being fruitful in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God; strengthened with all might, according to His glorious power, for all patience and long-suffering with joy; giving thanks to the Father who has qualified us to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in the light. He has delivered us from the power of darkness and conveyed us into the kingdom of the Son of His love, in whom we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins.” Colossians 1:9b-14*

Pray

- Offer thanksgiving to our Lord for His character – He is Loving, Just, Faithful, True, Merciful, Righteous, our Advocate, our Defense, the Rock, our Banner – our Miracle, the One who Sees, Healer, Salvation, Deliverer, Justifier, Purifier, Refiner, Perfector, Holy, our Provision, our Shield, our Strong Tower, etc.
- Express absolute faith and trust in God, alone.
- Confess any area in your life that has not been fully yielded to the Lord.
- That all corruption, dishonest practices, schemes and lying would be found out and swiftly brought to justice.
- Pray that hearts would be convicted of sin and that people would come forth to expose and give evidence of fraud and fraudulent practices, corruption, and treason.
- Proclaim - “Let God arise, Let His enemies be scattered; Let those also who hate Him flee before Him” in Jesus’ Name. Psalm 68:1 This is what was proclaimed at the moving of the ark of the covenant, the symbol of the manifest presence of God. See Numbers 10:35 **Pray that God’s Presence would manifest more clearly on this earth through His Spirit in the Body of Messiah.**
- Wisdom for our President and Vice President and their advisors. Pray protection over them and their families.
- That the strongholds would be torn down and utterly crushed in our lives, cities, state, and nation. We shall not return to them again.
- That the Body of Messiah would have a renewed fear of the LORD and unrelenting desire for His Presence, and that we would exalt His Word. See Psalm 138

- That liberty and freedom would be proclaimed in our land and to all the inhabitants thereof. See Leviticus 25:10 (the inscription on the Liberty Bell) Pray that every form of slavery and bondage would be broken and people would be liberated physically and spiritually into the Body of Messiah.
- Offer thanksgiving that God is the Master of Breakthroughs. See 2 Samuel 5 After the Conquest of Jerusalem, the Philistines heard that David had been anointed king over Israel, and they went up to search for David, who went down to the stronghold. He inquired of the Lord, “Shall I go up against the Philistines?” The Lord said, “Go up, for I will doubtless deliver the Philistines into your hand.” So David went to Baal Perazim and David defeated them there; and **he said, “the Lord has broken through my enemies before me, like a breakthrough of water.” Calling the name of that place Baal Perazim, literally “Master of Breakthroughs”**

In 1 Chron. 14:12 “And when they left their gods there, David gave a commandment, and they were burned with fire.” **Pray we destroy the idols and false gods that the Lord reveals in this time.**

- That we as the Body of Messiah would exude hope, trust, faith, and love to those around us and that we would be ready to give an answer for the reason for our hope. *1 Peter 3:15 “But in your hearts revere Christ as Lord. Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have. But do this with gentleness and respect.”*

*****November 11th, 11am - Call to join in possessing the ground of our nation, declare that it is One nation under God and for the Glory of God.**

On November 11, 1620 the Mayflower ship docked at Plymouth Rock. Before the Pilgrims disembarked from the ship to put their feet on the soil that would become the USA, they signed a covenant with YHVH. It is called the Mayflower Compact, America’s first constitution.

On the 400th anniversary of this historic event, Wednesday, November 11th, at 11 AM in each time zone, believers are asked to join in the re-affirmation and in the reestablishment of that covenant; declaring that we are ONE NATION UNDER GOD, and that JESUS CHRIST IS THE LORD OF THIS NATION.
