Coming Out of Egypt

To the Jewish people, Passover/Pesach is known as the "season of our freedom." It is the celebration of deliverance from bondage, out of a land of slavery, and the beginning of the journey to the promised land.

This year, Passover will begin on the evening of Saturday, March 27th and the Feast of Unleavened Bread lasts until the eve of Sunday, April 4th.

Let us meditate on Exodus 6:2-8, 9

"2And God spoke to Moses and said to him: 'I am the LORD. 3I appeared to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, as God Almighty, but by My name LORD I was not known to them. 4I have also established My covenant with them, to give them the land of Canaan, the land of their pilgrimage, in which they were strangers. 5And I have also heard the groaning of the children of Israel whom the Egyptians keep in bondage, and I have remembered My covenant. 6Therefore say to the children of Israel: 'I am the LORD; I will bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians, I will rescue you from their bondage, and I will redeem you with an outstretched arm and with great judgments. 7I will take you as My people, and I will be your God. Then you shall know that I am the LORD your God who brings you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians. 8And I will bring you in to the land which I swore to give to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob; and I will give it to you as a heritage: I am the LORD."

"So Moses spoke thus to the children of Israel; but they did not heed Moses, because of anguish of spirit and cruel bondage." Exodus 6:9

Is there anything in us that is not heeding You, Lord, because of anguish of spirit or cruel bondage?

May we be in a place of heart and mind that we believe You, Your promises, and Your word. Our faith is in You. No matter what -- may we obey You in faith.
