My Light and My Salvation

God is Light.

"This is the message which we have heard from Him and declare to you, that God is light and in Him is no darkness at all." 1 John 1:5

Let that declaration fill you with hope, peace, joy – and Light.

"In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God. All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made. In Him was life, and the life was the light of men. And the light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not comprehend it."

John 1:1-5

"Then Jesus spoke to them again, saying, 'I am the light of the world. He who follows Me shall not walk in darkness, but have the light of life." John 8:12

"1The LORD is my light and my salvation; Whom shall I fear?

The LORD is the strength of my life; Of whom shall I be afraid?...

8When You said, 'Seek My face,'

My heart said to You, 'Your face, LORD, I will seek."...

"14 You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden. 15 Neither do people light a lamp and put it under a basket. Instead, they put it on a lampstand so it gives light to all the house. 16 In the same way, let your light shine before men so they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven." Matthew 5:14-16 (TLV)

Pray

- Confess that the Lord is your Light and your Salvation. Thank Him that in Him is no darkness at all.
- Thank Him for the pureness of His light. Ask the Lord for intensification of His light on earth.
- Meditate on and pray through Psalm 27. Thank Him that we have nothing to fear. Confess that He is your strength.
- Seek His face and Wait on the Lord this week. What is He saying to you?
- Abba, help us to receive your command and commissioning, i.e., that You have placed us as light to the nations; may we yearn to bring Your salvation to the end of the earth.
- That we would walk in the light (Ephesians 5:8-14), that we would shine before men, perform good works (Ephesians 2:10), and that the Father would be glorified.
- For the fruitless deeds of darkness to be exposed. (Ephesians 5:11, Isaiah 5:20 "Woe to those who call evil good, and good evil; who put darkness for light and light for darkness, who present bitter as sweet, and sweet as bitter!")
