God Hears

"Therefore will I look to the Lord; I will wait for the God of my salvation: my God will hear me." Micah 7:7

I find great consolation in the fact that God hears me. Whether it is in the quiet of my heart, or during the rush of my day; He honors the yearning to be led by Him, have godly wisdom, be guided by the Holy Spirit, and the desperation for His will to be done and His word to be fulfilled on this earth.

“¹⁹Are you inquiring among yourselves about what I said, ‘A little while, and you will not see Me; and again a little while, and you will see Me’? ²⁰Most assuredly, I say to you that you will weep and lament, but the world will rejoice; and you will be sorrowful, but your sorrow will be turned into joy. ²¹A woman, when she is in labor, has sorrow because her hour has come; but as soon as she has given birth to the child, she no longer remembers the anguish, for joy that a human being has been born into the world. ²²Therefore you now have sorrow; but I will see you again and your heart will rejoice, and your joy no one will take from you. ²³And in that day you will ask Me nothing. Most assuredly, I say to you, whatever you ask the Father in My name He will give you. ²⁴Until now you have asked nothing in My name. Ask, and you will receive, that your joy may be full.” John 16:19b-24

“Now this is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. And if we know that He hears us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of Him.” 1 John 5:14-15

“So Jesus answered and said to them, ‘Have faith in God. “²⁴But He, because He continues forever, has an unchangeable priesthood. ²⁵Therefore He is also able to save to the uttermost those who come to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them.” Hebrews 7:24-25

- For the Holy Spirit to guide our prayers.

Now He who searches the hearts knows what the mind of the Spirit is, because He makes intercession for the saints according to the will of God.”

Romans 8:26-27

- For boldness to ask for whatever Holy Spirit shows us to pray, and that we would see God move mightily in this earth.
- That we would be encouraged by the fact that we approach the Father in Jesus, having confidence in His position and righteousness, and He also is making intercession for us.
