August 30 – September 5, 2021

### Declare His glory

As I have been in prayer this week, the command to declare the Lord's glory and proclaim His good works has been a repeated theme that the Lord has impressed upon me. It serves as a witness to a lost and broken world, it gives us comfort, confidence, and courage to continue to rely on the One who has always been faithful, and it also is necessary to battle in the spiritual realm.

### Psalm 96

*<sup>1</sup>Oh, sing to the LORD a new song! Sing to the LORD, all the earth.*

*<sup>2</sup>Sing to the LORD, bless His name; Proclaim the good news of His salvation from day to day.*

*<sup>3</sup>Declare His glory among the nations, His wonders among all peoples.*

*<sup>4</sup>For the LORD is great and greatly to be praised; He is to be feared above all gods.*

*<sup>5</sup>For all the gods of the peoples are idols, but the LORD made the heavens.*

*<sup>6</sup>Honor and majesty are before Him; Strength and beauty are in His sanctuary.*

*<sup>7</sup>Give to the LORD, O families of the peoples, Give to the LORD glory and strength.*

*<sup>8</sup>Give to the LORD the glory due His name; Bring an offering, and come into His courts.*

*<sup>9</sup>Oh, worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness! Tremble before him, all the earth.*

*<sup>10</sup>Say among the nations, 'The LORD reigns; The world also is firmly established, it shall not be moved; He shall judge the peoples righteously.'*

*<sup>11</sup>Let the heavens rejoice, and let the earth be glad; Let the sea roar, and all its fullness;*

*<sup>12</sup>Let the field be joyful, and all that is in it. Then all the trees of the woods will rejoice <sup>13</sup>before the LORD.*

*For He is coming, for He is coming to judge the earth. He shall judge the world with righteousness, and the peoples with His truth.*

### **Psalm 145**

*<sup>1</sup>I will extol You, my God, O king; And I will bless Your name forever and ever.*

*<sup>2</sup>Every day I will bless You, and I will praise Your name forever and ever.*

*<sup>3</sup>Great is the LORD, and greatly to be praised; and His greatness is unsearchable.*

*<sup>4</sup>One generation shall praise Your works to another, and shall declare Your mighty acts.*

*<sup>5</sup>I will meditate on the glorious splendor of Your majesty, and on Your wondrous works.*

*<sup>6</sup>Men shall speak of the might of Your awesome acts, and I will declare Your greatness.*

*<sup>7</sup>They shall utter the memory of Your great goodness, and shall sing of Your righteousness.*

*<sup>8</sup>The LORD is gracious and full of compassion, slow to anger and great in mercy.*

*<sup>9</sup>The LORD is good to all, and His tender mercies are over all His works.*

*<sup>10</sup>All Your works shall praise You, O LORD, and Your saints shall bless You.*

*<sup>11</sup>They shall speak of the glory of Your kingdom, and talk of Your power,*

*<sup>12</sup>To make known to the sons of men His mighty acts, and the glorious majesty of His kingdom.*

*<sup>13</sup>Your kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and Your dominion endures throughout all generations.*

*<sup>14</sup>The LORD upholds all who fall, and raises up all who are bowed down.*

*<sup>15</sup>The eyes of all look expectantly to You, and You give them their food in due season.*

*<sup>16</sup>You open Your hand and satisfy the desire of every living thing.*

*<sup>17</sup>The LORD is righteous in all His ways, gracious in all His works.*

*<sup>18</sup>The LORD is near to all who call upon Him, to all who call upon Him in truth.*

*<sup>19</sup>He will fulfill the desire of those who fear Him; He also will hear their cry and save them.*

*<sup>20</sup>The LORD preserves all who love Him, but all the wicked He will destroy.*

*<sup>21</sup>My mouth shall speak the praise of the LORD, and all flesh shall bless His holy name forever and ever.*

## Pray

- Worship; declare His glory and proclaim His good works. Remember and thank Him for all He has done. Declare that He reigns. *“Give to the LORD the glory due His name; bring an offering, and come into His courts. Oh, worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness! Tremble before Him, all the earth.”* Psalm 96:8-9
- For the body of Messiah to repent and seek His face. See Joel 2.

*“Hear, O LORD, when I cry with my voice! Have mercy also upon me, and answer me. When You said, ‘Seek My face,’ My heart said to You, ‘Your face, Lord, I will seek.’”* Psalm 27:7-8

- For the fear of the Lord to fall upon the earth. *“Say among the nations, ‘The LORD reigns; The world also is firmly established, it shall not be moved; He shall judge the peoples righteously.’”* Psalm 96:10

*“For He is coming, for He is coming to judge the earth. He shall judge the world with righteousness, and the peoples with His truth.”* Psalm 96:13

- Abide in the vine. Sense the urgency of the hour, and pray for the body of Messiah to bear much fruit.

*<sup>1</sup>I am the true vine, and My Father is the vinedresser. <sup>2</sup>Every branch in Me that does not bear fruit He takes away, and every branch that bears fruit He prunes, that It may bear more fruit. <sup>3</sup>You are already clean because of the word which I have spoken to you. <sup>4</sup>Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in Me. <sup>5</sup>I am the vine; you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing. <sup>6</sup>If anyone does not abide in Me, he is cast out as a branch and is withered; and they gather them and throw them into the fire, and they are burned. <sup>7</sup>If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you. <sup>8</sup>By this My Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit; so you will be My disciples.”* John 15:1-8

- Ask for the Lord to pour out His Holy Spirit upon the earth. See Joel 2

*“So he answered and said to me: ‘This is the word of the Lord to Zerubbabel: ‘Not by might or be power, but by My Spirit,’ says the Lord of hosts.” Zechariah 4:6*
