I have been contemplating the following verses for a couple of weeks now, and am greatly encouraged at the thought of being perfected, established, strengthened, and settled as 1 Peter 5:8-11 (*see below*) describes. However, the precondition should not be ignored, that is, "after you have suffered a while."

"Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil walks about like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour. ⁹Resist him, steadfast in the faith, knowing that the same sufferings are experienced by your brotherhood in the world. ¹⁰But may the God of all grace, who called us to His eternal glory by Christ Jesus, after you have suffered a while, perfect, establish, strengthen, and settle you. ¹¹To Him be the glory and the dominion forever and ever. Amen" 1 Peter 5:8-11

We are called to be sober (of sound mind), and vigilant (stay awake, responsible, watchful) because we have an enemy. We must resist (withstand) him, being steadfast in the faith (against his onset - rooted, established, strong, immovable and determined). And He who has called you to His own eternal glory in Christ Jesus, "will Himself complete and make you what you ought to be...." (See Amplified, 1 Peter 5:8-11)
