Waist girded, Lamps burning

"35Let your waist be girded and your lamps burning; 36 and you yourselves be like men who wait for their master, when he will return from the wedding, that when he comes and knocks they may open to him immediately, 37Blessed are those servants whom the master, when he comes, will find watching. Assuredly, I say to you that he will gird himself and have them sit down to eat, and will come and serve them.

38And if he should come in the second watch, or come in the third watch, and find them so, blessed are those servants. 39But know this, that if the master of the house had known what hour the thief would come, he would have watched and not allowed his house to be broken into. 40Therefore you also be ready, for the Son of Man is coming at an hour you do not expect." Luke 12:35-40

The Lord's instructions in the above passage tell us to gird our waists, that is, be working/serving. Also, it can mean to ensure our clothing is fixed in place, i.e., to protect ourselves from deception, as in - not letting our guard down.

He also tells us to have our lamps burning. We should be constantly on watch and waiting for His return, ready to welcome Him – keeping the light on and our lamps full. We can be sure that He will come at an hour we do not expect, and we can be sure that we will be blessed for being ready.
